The Pacific Northwest Conference is Launching a Worship Video Library

What is a Worship Video Library? It is a private, curated collection of videos which can be borrowed for use in local church worship services. The video library includes videos of worship music, sermons, prayers, litanies, and more. They have been shared to the library with permission by the musician, preacher, leader, etc. Any PNC church is welcome to use videos from the library, at their convenience, and at *no cost* to the local church.

This library is intended to help support local churches with the ongoing work of creating on-line worship experiences. Videos can be used to supplement a worship service, for instance, by adding an additional musical interlude, or several videos can be compiled into an entire worship service.

The PNC Worship Video Library is hosted on Vimeo. Vimeo is a free-to-join video sharing website. Access to the PNC Worship Video Library is also free, but it is a private channel on Vimeo and registration is required. To register, you will need to follow these steps:

1. Create a Vimeo Account
2. "Follow" the Pacific Northwest Conference on Vimeo. You can find the PNC account at <https://vimeo.com/pacificnorthwestucc>

After emailing Arlene, permission will be granted through the conference office, by adding each individual user to an "allowed" list on Vimeo. You will receive an email which indicates your registration has been received and you have been added. Once permission is granted, the channel can be "Followed" to make it easier to find the channel with subsequent visits.
